Stop Work Policy

All *Samos Steamship Co.*, employees, contractors and guests are responsible for stopping work activities that are considered to be an *imminent danger* (i.e. any condition or behaviour that could reasonably be expected to cause death or serious injury, or environmental harm). The Responsible Officer should then be informed about.

Samos Steamship Co. believes that no work is so urgent that we cannot take time to do it safely.

For prevention of injury to people, damage to property and the environment the Company's "Stop Work Policy" shall prevail when:

- Work activities impose an immediate danger to life, health and environment;
- Action of a person or a team is not in compliance with the set standards and procedures for performing a task.



Note: When in doubt about a safety condition, contact your Responsible Officer.

How to react when someone stops you from what you are doing:

- Be polite & patient
- Listen to what the person has to say
- Agree to an action
- Be polite and thank the person who stopped the work
- Inform your Responsible Officer about so as to restart the work

How to say to someone to stop the work he is doing:

- Be polite
- Request to stop the work
- Ask direct questions (why, what, how) about the task and explain what you observed
- Agree an action with the person you stopped and report as appropriate.
